

Grange Sunflower Block

Cut:

Fabric A - For Background: (Blue, Dark/Navy)

4 squares 2" x 2"

4 rectangles 3 ½" x 6 ½"

4 rectangles 2 x 3 ½"

Fabric B - For Leaves: Green

4 squares 2" x 2"

Fabric C - For Sunflower Petals: (yellow, gold)

8 squares 3 ½" x 3 ½"

Fabric D - For Center: (brown, dark)

1 square 6 ½" x 6 ½"

1. Sew together one each of the 2" x 2" squares Fabric A & B. Stitch 1 Fabric A 2" x 3 ½" rectangle to the 2" Fab A & B set just made. Do this 4 times. See Diagram I and II

2. Draw diagonal line on wrong side of Fabric C-yellow 3 ½" square. Place marked square on Fabric A 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle, right sides together. Stitch on drawn line; trim away and discard excess fabric. Open and press. Repeat on opposite end of rectangle to make pieced rectangle. Make 4. See Diagram III

3. Sew 3 rows using step 1 block corners, pieced rectangles, and 1 Fabric D square. Stitch rows together. Refer to Diagram IV
